This is a 16-hour, two- part introductory course on The Kinesio Taping® Method (KTM). Specialist focus may be on improving function/pain for TMJ related concerns, or dysfunctions associated with muscles affecting facial expression, chewing, swallowing, tongue ROM, lip closure, etc.

- Four (4) hours online pre-course on The Kinesio Taping® Method (KTM)
- 12 hours of direct instruction/workshop.

Objectives: At the completion of this course, participant will be able to:

1. Name corrective taping strategies aligned with The Kinesio Taping® Method (KTM).
2. Use qualitative/quantitative methods as diagnostic tools to measure pre/post outcomes of learned corrective taping techniques associated with the Kinesio® Medical Taping (KMT™).
3. Participate in a group case study to help create a plan of care (SOAP note format). The group will include qualitative/quantitative assessment information (e.g., “problem list”, MDT, common industry used assessment examples) to rationalize the use of a learned Kinesio Tape® application. The participant will also list precautions, contraindications, and a recommended HEP.
4. Engage in guided laboratory training, with focus on assessment methods, treatment methods, and uses of elastic therapeutic tape with Kinesio Tape®.

*Participants will have hands-on opportunities to use, cut, and apply Kinesio Tape® within instructed modules.

*The four hour online pre-course, behind The Kinesio Taping® Method (KTM), is a required interdisciplinary course for participants..

- A. Sensory Point with Kinesio® Medical Taping (KMT™)
 - a. This is a 12-hour introductory course provided via direct instruction. This course focuses on applying Kinesio Tape® Correction strategies (learned from the pre-course) to use for improved function in the oral/facial, breath, and digestion.
 - b. The participant will lab eight (8) corrective techniques (EDF, Fascia, Mechanical, Space, Ligament/Tendon, Functional and Circulatory) and a specialty cut (SPT). The participant will also be introduced to scar remodeling using a 72 tuning fork and Kinesio Tape®.
 - c. The participant will participate in a group case study to help create a plan of care (SOAP note format). The group will include qualitative/quantitative assessment information (e.g., “problem list”, MDT, common industry used assessment examples) to rationalize the use of a learned Kinesio Tape® application for the face, neck, and/or scar management/vibroacoustic. The participant will also list precautions, contraindications, and a recommended HEP.
